

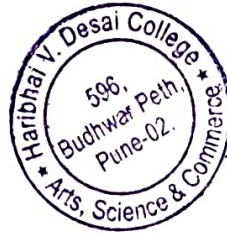


**Participant Feedback:**

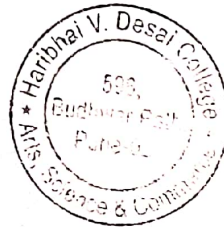

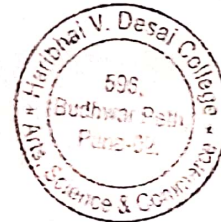
