



Conclusion:

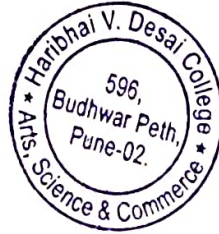
