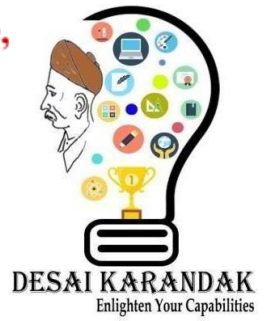

General Rules:

1. Registration fee per student per competition is Rs. 50/- only which is **not refundable**.
2. Registration will be confirmed when the fee is paid.
3. The Participants should be present 30 minutes before the competition with their college I-card.
4. **This competition is open for UG and PG students from all the streams .**
5. A student may participate in more than one competition. However, if multiple competitions are scheduled at the same time, the student must choose only one. In such cases, no refund will be provided.
6. One time refreshment will be provided.
7. **Certificates will be awarded to all the participants and students will receive one credit for participation.**
8. The judges' decisions will be final and binding, and no appeals will be entertained.

Elimination Round

Instructions:

1. The time duration for this round is 30 Minutes.
2. Calculator, log table, mobiles or any other mathematical tables are not allowed.
3. There are no negative marks for wrong answers.
4. The candidate has to tick mark (✓) the appropriate answer.
5. More than one tick will be considered as wrong.
6. If options are not available then write an answer. More than one answer will be considered as wrong.
7. The paper will not be available after declaration of result.

Final Round

Instructions:

1. Each team will get 40 minutes to complete the task.
2. Two tasks will be assigned to each team.
3. Calculator, log table, mobiles or any other mathematical tables are not allowed.
4. The decision of the judges will be final.

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Webguru

1. The competition will be conducted in two rounds.
2. Individual participation only.

Elimination Round

1. Each participant will get one question paper.
2. There are no negative marks for wrong answers.
3. **The time duration for this round is 30 Minutes.**
4. The candidate has to tick mark (✓) the appropriate answer.
5. More than one tick will be considered as wrong.
6. The paper will not be available after declaration of result.

Final Round

1. Language for designing: **HTML and CSS**
2. The Participant has to design a minimum 3 pages of a website based on the competition theme.
(Topics will be provided at the time of competition).
3. The Internet will be available for downloading images and templates.
4. The time duration for this round is **45 min.**
5. Winners will be decided by combining first-round and final-round scores.
6. The decision of the judges will be final.



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Debate Competition

1. The competition will be held in 2 rounds.
2. Only 2 members will be allowed in one team. One should speak in favour and the other will be in against.
3. Three languages are allowed for debate. (Marathi /Hindi/English)
4. For the First round, a warning bell will be given after 6 minutes; the final bell will be after 1 minute. If time exceeds, marks will be deducted.
5. For the final round 1-minute extempore subject will be given at the time of competition.
6. Facts presented in a debate must be accurate.
7. If a speaker makes a statement they must be able to provide evidence or reasons to support the statement.
8. The team supporting the motion must not shift its point of view.
9. The decision of judges will be final.

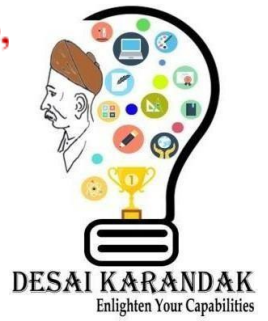

5. Competition is open for all streams.



Mind to Model (Model Competition)

Eligibility : Undergraduate and Postgraduate students (Arts, Science and Commerce)

Organizing Department: Microbiology (PG)

Participation Rules:

1. The competition is open for all undergraduate and postgraduate students (Arts, Science and Commerce)
2. Registration fees per student per event is Rs. 50/- only, which is not refundable.
3. Registration will be confirmed when the fee is paid.
4. a team of 2 students is allowed to participate.
5. Models can be 2D (flat, with length and width) or 3D (with length, width, and depth)
7. Model display space provided : 2 feet x 2 feet
8. The participants should be present 30 minutes before the event
9. Participants must have the Identity card of his / her college.
10. One time refreshment will be provided.
11. Certificates will be awarded to all participants.
12. Unethical behavior could lead to disqualification.
13. The decisions of Judges will be final.
14. The organization team will have all the rights to take final decisions for any matter during the event.

Topics for Models:

1. **Deepfake detection** (For example: Build a model that can identify and analyze manipulated video or audio media to combat misinformation)
2. **AI-driven solutions for Healthcare sector** (For examples: Personalized Medicines, Edible Vaccines, Mental Health & Well being Model)
3. **Evolution of Currency** (For example: A model showing the historical progression from bartering to digital currencies)
4. **Digital India** (For example: A model representing the impact of digital services on businesses and consumers)
5. **Unseen Monument** (For example: Build a model of a monument that represents a historical event or person but is not yet built or exists only in concept)



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6. **Shape of Sound** (Interpret a piece of music or a specific sound—like a storm or a soft whisper—as a three-dimensional form)
7. **Rights, Justice & Society** (Models based on freedom, equality, education & health)

Eco Innovation Competition- Shape the future of Planet

Eligibility : Undergraduate and Postgraduate students (Arts, Science and Commerce)

Organizing Department: Environmental Science (PG)

Topics:

1. Smart cities: Focusing on energy efficiency and sustainability
2. Sustainable Agriculture: Focusing on Water & Soil conservation
3. Waste management: Focusing on reduction & management of Waste
4. DIY Pollution monitoring: Track, Measure, Act

Rules:

1. Registration fees per student per event is Rs. 50/- only which is not refundable.
2. Registration will be confirmed when the fee is paid.
3. The Participants should be present 30 minutes before the event with their college I-card.
4. **This competition is open for all stream students appearing in UG and PG.**
5. One student can participate in one or more than one event. If an event is conducted in parallel shown in the time table, students have to make a choice to appear for anyone. In such cases no refund is given.
6. One time refreshment will be provided.
7. **Certificates will be awarded to all participants and students will get one credit for participation.**
8. The decisions by judges will be final and not open to appeal.
9. Students should participate in groups of 2 members.
10. Students have to present their ideas in the form of PPT Presentation (if required prepare & present model as well.).
11. Time limit for presenting ideas is 5 minutes
12. The ideas should be sustainable and scientific, and it should be linked with the given themes.
13. The ideas must be original, innovative & the team's own work.
14. For models, teams may use eco-friendly, recycled or low-cost materials

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15. PPT should not exceed 4-5 slides.



Competitions for Junior College Students:

TREASURE HUNT

1. There are approximately 9 teams, each consisting of 4 members.
2. There will be a colour code given to each team, which should be there on their right side of the chest till the winning point.
3. In case their colour code is missing, by any of the team members, that team will be disqualified.
4. Basic information behind the colour code is, you must hunt all the 6 clues of your own colour only. All these clues should be with you collectively, to be declared as THE WINNING TEAM
5. There will be an elimination round of the treasure hunt, first. Wherein, we have to choose only 3 teams. These 3 teams will finally go for the TREASURE HUNT!
6. The winning team must reach the auditorium within 1hr. If not, then at least nearby the auditorium. To be declared as the winning team.
7. Your team cannot split up.
8. You have to collect all the 6 clues of your own colour code envelope, of your own team, till the winning point. All of the clues are in simple English language. Still, in case you don't understand, you may take the help of your volunteer.
9. A head start will be given. This means that you cannot view the clues, or leave the starting site without it having been announced that THE HUNT HAS BEGUN!
10. Malpractices will lead to throwing the team out of hunt. Cameras are installed at each & every corner + discipline committee to maintain the decorum & to have a clear cut view.
11. The team captain is entirely responsible for all works done by the team members.
12. Mobile phones are strictly banned at the time of race.
13. Any team seeking advice from people outside the race other than the volunteers, will be disqualified.
14. Help from the volunteers can be taken for knowing the places.
15. Any team that tries to physically obstruct the hunt for the other teams will be disqualified.
16. There will be a time limit for your treasure hunt. A definite starting time and a time to report to the finishing.
