Outcomes:

Guppashtaka is a chat group to develop qualities in students:

1. These are critical thinking about oneself and understand the realities on the ground work.
2. To understand each other with respect to oneself.
3. To live a motivated life through sharing.
4. Create new friendships that are more meaningful and logical.
5. Communicating with ease and with self-dignity.

Outcomes of present chat on "Family and my role in Covid"

Students help parents in the following way:

1. Paying online bills
2. Support in cooking and household activities.
3. Support in teaching and learning of the siblings.
4. Some boys help parents in their family run small scale units / trading, etc.
5. Students took care of their family when members had covid.
6. Providing tiffin to neighbours suffering from covid also has been reported.
7. Sharing resources with relatives who had small homes so that covid patient in a family could be quarantined effectively.

Problems faced:

1. More than 60% students have houses which are small and the family has at least 5 members
2. About 20% students have 1 BHK houses.
3. Most families have lesser gadgets than number of members in the house.
4. Learning environments are not conducive.
5. Some feel depressed because of lack of resources and inability to move out
