



Academic Exposure to Advanced Instrumentation: Visit to CIF. SPPU



The Department of Microbiology (PG) organized an educational visit to the Central Instrumentation Facility (CIF) at Savitribai Phule Pune University (SPPU) on 17th April 2025, with the objective of enhancing students' understanding of advanced analytical instruments utilized in scientific research.

A total of 38 M.Sc. Part I students, accompanied by two faculty members, participated in the visit. Students were introduced to sophisticated equipment such as Nuclear Magnetic Resonance (NMR), Field Emission Scanning Electron Microscopy (FESEM), Liquid Chromatography-Mass Spectrometer (LCMS), Gas Chromatography-Mass Spectrometer (GCMS), Atomic Force Microscopy (AFM), and X-ray Diffractometer (XRD).

Technical experts provided insights into the principles, construction, and operational mechanisms of these instruments. The visit proved to be highly beneficial in strengthening students' conceptual clarity and practical orientation, thereby supporting their ongoing and future research endeavors.
